

### A Note From the Organist:

A few words about the organ may be in order today. The organ of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church was originally built in 1959 as Opus 1254 of the Reuter Organ Company of Lawrence, Kansas, which is still in business and recently externated their 100th anniversary. The organ consisted of 21 ranks spread over 3 manuals and pedal, with approximately 1300 pipes. Despite the fact that because of cost and space considerations the organ had to be designed as a "minimalist" instrument, the Reuter installation crew did an excellent job of voicing and the organ served well for many years.

By 2011, however, the console was showing definite signs of age. Certain components had become unreliable, and the wind system was leaking. The Rodgers Instrument Company of Hillsboro, Oregon installed a new console in 2013 including digital stops, interfaced with the existing organ, and other necessary repairs were done. The organ is now equivalent to approximately 55 ranks, and is a more complete instrument. All of the original Reuter pipework continues to sound, and the digital ranks provide many tone colors not previously available.





I believe in one God, the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth and of all things visible and invisible.




### **Proper Preface**


