<sup>13</sup>So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love.



Let us pray for the whole Church of God in Christ Jesus and for all people according to their needs.



### A Note From The Organist:

"Precious Lord, Take My Hand" was written by Thomas A. Dorsey (1899-1993) who wrote many gospel hymns. He is credited with both text and music, bit the melody bears a striking resemblance to a nineteenth century American tune. Dorsey altered it enough to give it a blues feeling.

Timothy Shaw has received many honors for his compositions in many genres. His setting of "Precious Lord" begins with the melody played by the pedal, using a 2-foot stop, which sounds two octaves above the written pitch. He then enters the minor mode, and finally brings the melody back to major, with the pedal returning to its usual bass line.

Paul Mainz's setting is a prelude and fughetta, played on the full choruses with powerful chords, eventually reaching full organ.
